The City of Corsicana, established in 1848 as the county seat of Navarro County, is located 53 miles to the southeast of the Dallas/Ft. Worth Metroplex area and 54 miles northeast of Waco at I-45/ US Highway 287 and Texas State Highway 31. Richland-Chambers Lake, the 3rd largest in the State of Texas, is located 10 miles southeast of Corsicana off US Highway 287.

Corsicana is an industrial and commercial center. The area has the longest continuous oil flow in Texas, with a total production in excess of 200 million barrels since 1895. Minerals produced in the area include oil, gas, sand, and gravel. Corsicana is defined by industries, railroads, oil, and agriculture/cattle.

Corsicana and the surrounding area offer several recreational opportunities to enjoy. There are 12 parks that cover approximately 600 acres, 3 lakes including Richland Chambers, the third largest lake in the State of Texas, 2 golf courses (1 public, 1 private), and 49 Tennis Courts. There are also several entertainment venues that cover everything from movies to music including The Palace Theatre, The Warehouse Living Arts Center and an outdoor amphitheatre for concerts. Three health centers and a YMCA are available for all of your fitness needs.

Corsicana has an excellent education system with one high school, one middle/jr. high, one intermediate school, four elementary schools and five private schools. The enrollment of the Corsicana ISD is 5,722 and the private schools is 270.

Corsicana also offers options for higher education with Navarro College offering associate level degrees and Texas A&M Commerce offering Bachelors and Graduate level degrees.
